Chuck Moore passed away on Friday, April 22nd at his home in Chickasaw Point, SC. Chuck retired in 2009 after a long career in Broadcasting. He began as a cameraman / sports photographer with KTBS in Shreveport, LA, quickly becoming Sportscaster, then Anchor. In 1969 he went to KCMO in Kansas City, MO as Anchor, moving to Atlanta in 1972 to work at WAGA. In 1979 he became Anchor for WXIA and stayed there until 1997. In 1999 he came out of retirement to work at WNEG in Toccoa, GA as Anchor, and mentor to young broadcast students. Retiring for good in 2009, Chuck spent a lot of time on the golf course, which was a joy.

Chuck is survived by his wife of 48 years, Deborah Moore, brother Greg Moore, children Darby Parrish, Vicki Hooten, Mickey Hooten, Karen Hicks and Mark Moore, grandchildren Derek Bruno, Michael Parrish, Madison Bruno, Marissa Hicks, Zak Moore, Melanie Hicks and Max Moore, great grandchildren Parker and Averri Parrish.
