Corinne “Connie” Moore Stoker, age 61, died November 22, 2015, at the GHS Hospice of the Foothills Cottingham House in Seneca, South Carolina.

Connie Stoker was born in Atlanta, Georgia on August 25, 1954, the daughter of James Norris Moore III and Gussie Sinclair Foster Moore. She attended school at Westminster in Atlanta and graduated from the University of Virginia in 1975 with a BA in Psychology and induction into Phi Beta Kappa.
