



## Mr. Curtis Powell Lane

September 5, 1938 - March 28, 2026

Curtis Powell Lane was born September 5, 1938, the youngest of eleven children. He grew up in Goldsboro, North Carolina, and served his country in Vietnam and Korea. In 1961, Curtis married Irma Evans, with whom he shared his life for 64 years and raised their children, Hope, Melissa, and Curtis Jr. He guided each of them lovingly throughout their lives, but he mentored many other people who looked to him with great respect. After retiring as Master Sergeant in the Army, he owned his own business in Fayetteville. In 1993, this North Carolina native moved to West Union and was soon looked upon as a South Carolina local. He retired as a beloved custodian at Walhalla High School after 20 years of service. Curtis died peacefully at home on March 28, 2026. He was a child of God, an admired mentor, and faithful family man we will never forget. A memorial service will be held on April 11, 2026, at 2:00 at Fairview Community Church, 334 Ebenezer Road, West Union, SC.
