David Eugene McAbee, 88, husband of Alice Norene Jung McAbee, passed away peacefully on May 27, 2026, at Cottingham Hospice House.

A native of Charlotte, NC, Mr. McAbee was the son of the late James T. and Viola Hollis McAbee. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force having served for nine years.
