When their youngest child turned 8, Pauline went to work as a successful Interior Designer in Sharon, PA, and then she became a Real Estate Agent in Atlanta, GA after her husband's job transfer. After another transfer to Tennessee, she opened a woman's clothing store. A final move back to Atlanta, Pauline became the first employee of Residence Inn in Georgia, where she worked until age 70 in Human Resources. Upon retirement, Pauline & Paul built and moved into their home on Lake Hartwell where they made many more years of happy memories together.

In addition to husband Paul, Pauline is survived by her daughter Mary Lee Ackley, son Paul Reckert, Jr. and daughter-in-law Selena, daughter Nancy and son-in-law Joel Nevins.
