Robert "Bob" John Stoiber, 77, lost his battle with Alzheimer's and went home to be with the Lord on July 9, 2023. Bob was born in Milwaukee, WI on September 5, 1945. He attended undergraduate school at Marquette University and completed his graduate degree at Northwestern University. He began his career as an electrical engineer for Square D in Schaumburg, IL which eventually brought him to Seneca, SC in 1987. After leaving Square D, he and his wife Jane, started the Paul Davis Systems franchise for Oconee / Pickens County in 1989 and retired in 2011.

Bob or "Bobbie" as his Grandkids called him, enjoyed spending time with his family more than anything. Bobbie was always excited when the grandkids would come visit and would be waiting in his lawn chair in the driveway to greet them and would give them their schnitzel crunches. A few of his favorite activities with his grandkids were taking them on boat rides on Lake Hartwell and watching them swim and fish, "floating" in the lake, treating them to an annual vacation in Hilton Head and attending all of their activities and sporting events.

Bob and Jane enjoyed traveling and spending time with life long friends from his home town, home improvement projects, going to Charlotte to visit their daughters and families, entertaining and hanging out with friends, and watching golf and football. He was an avid Greenbay Packers and Clemson

fan. He also knew everything about golf.

When Bob was not enjoying time with his family he always found time to sneak in a nap. He was particularly fond of napping with his grand dog, Riggins and was in sync with the grandkids nap schedules when they were little.

Bob embraced retirement. He appreciated a nice hotel and particularly a great meal of meat and potatoes, prime rib being his favorite. He would often bring his own condiments as he was very partial to Heinz ketchup.

The last years of Bob's life were full of family, friends, dogs, lake activities and love. In his last days, he would constantly make comments about the beauty of his property and city.

Bob is survived by his loving wife, Mary Jane Stoiber, sister Marlene Stoiber Burroughs, daughters Stacey Lynn Stoiber Murphy, Stefanie Anne Stoiber Martin, Grandchildren Carter Martin, Luke Murphy, Madison Murphy, Tucker Martin, and his two son in laws that he considered sons, Nathan Murphy and Jason Martin.
